CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

This Code of Conduct is for all students participating in any Rodolfus Foundation event.

General Behaviour

- You are expected to behave sensibly and responsibly at all times. If you are in any difficulty, please talk to a member of the Senior Team (Course Director, Course Manager and House Parents).
- You must attend all sessions, unless you have written permission of the Course Director to do otherwise.
- Any damage to venue or Foundation property must be reported immediately to your House Parent.
- You are expected to respond courteously to staff and to interact with other participants in a kind and friendly manner.
- You are expected to use devices, technology and social media appropriately. For further guidance please see **Digital & E-Safety – Acceptable Use (Students)**.

Boarding

- You may not leave the course venue nor be absent from meals without the permission of your Course Manager.
- Male students are not permitted to be in female students' boarding house/room(s), nor are female students allowed in the male students' boarding house/room(s), at any time. If you need to contact someone, you must ask the relevant House Parent.
- All belongings and money kept in your room are your own responsibility. However, you may hand over any valuable documents (passports, etc.) to your House Parent for safekeeping, should you wish to do so.

Prohibited Items

- The use of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, drugs or illegal substances of any kind is absolutely forbidden at all times, and their possession alone will be enough to ensure a student's immediate return home.
